Vinification: Grape harvest in 21° Brix. Direct pressing, without maceration. Fermentation in temperature control. Bottled without barrels contact.

Tasting Notes:

Visual: Light salmon pink, extraordinary cleanliness and brightness. High luminosity and medium density indicting lower alcohol.

Nose: Pleasant aromas of young red fruits such as strawberries, raspberries and touches of peaches are present. It also presents delicacy floral notes.

Taste: A wine with delicious freshness, rich acidity, long permanence, aftertaste of delicate fruitiness, medium body and outstanding harmony.

Recommended Paring: Medium intensity dishes such as fruits of the sea: oysters, clams, abalone, lobster and white meat fish with light/medium sauce. Also, perfect for vegetables, salads and pastas with seafood.

Recommended Serving Temperature: 50-53° F Limited Production: 1,200 bottles produced.
